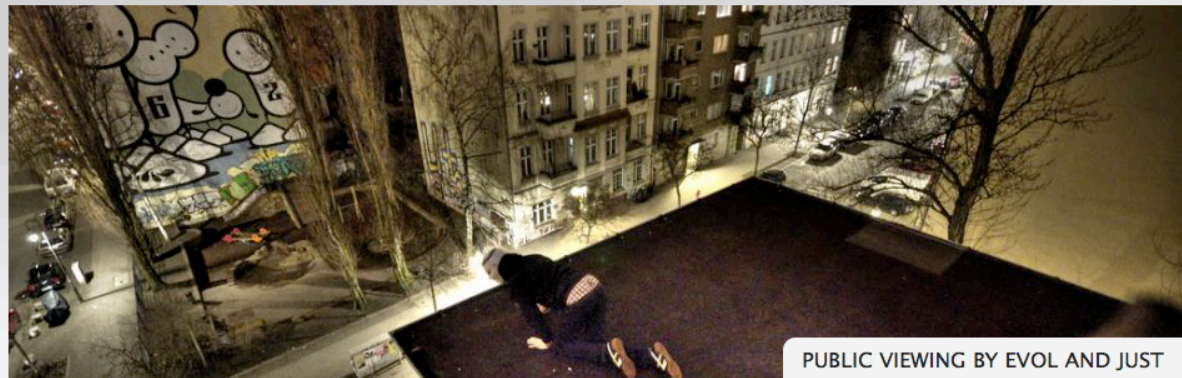

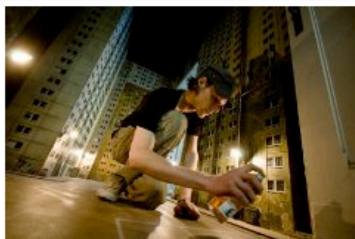
Under the umbrella of the fourth edition of the European Month of Photography graf legends Evol and Just were invited to untie and present *Public Viewing* at the Wilde Gallery in Berlin.



This fourth edition of the European Month of Photography presents itself as a festival in transition. The 'month' of photography lasts for six weeks, starting – in response to the rhythm of Berlin's cultural autumn – in mid-October. The biggest change however is the experiment of confronting all

participating institutions with a mandatory set theme. 'Modern times, new pictures' is the phrase that sums it all up – a theme focusing on photography as an instrument of modernization. After all, it has long been a matter of general knowledge that photographs do more than just 'reproduce reality'.

Evol's and Just's photographs for example show a reality of urban life from a perspective that few people have access to; a perspective of two young artists that literally leave traces, where ever they go.



Photographer and graffiti and stencil artist Evol shows his work in a-typical cityscapes, which are ironic and nostalgic snapshots of humorist and poetic moments. The work of the accomplished photographer Just on the other hand has been described by Martha Cooper as 'dramatic documents of daring graffiti artists in action.' While being published in the NY Times and Spiegel Online, he shows youth subculture right in between social protest and political change.
